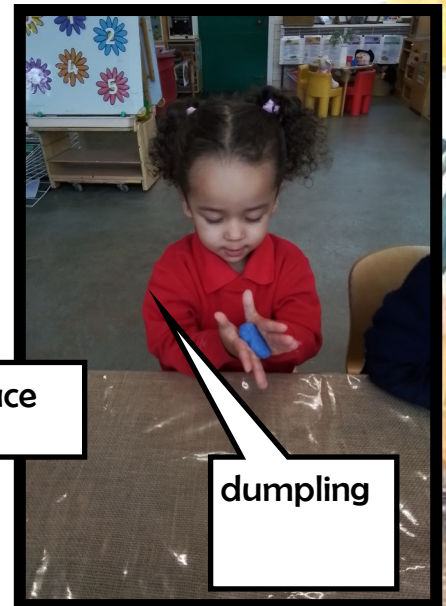
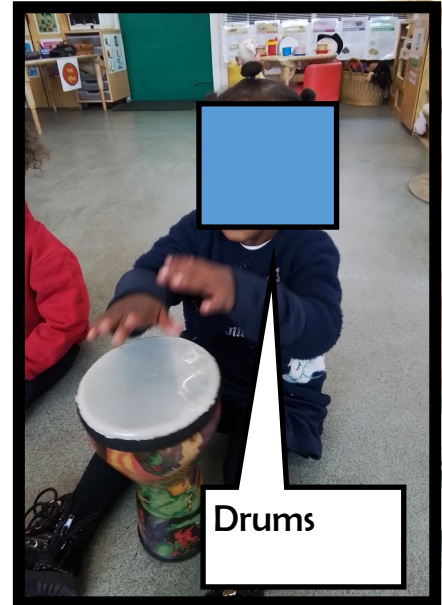
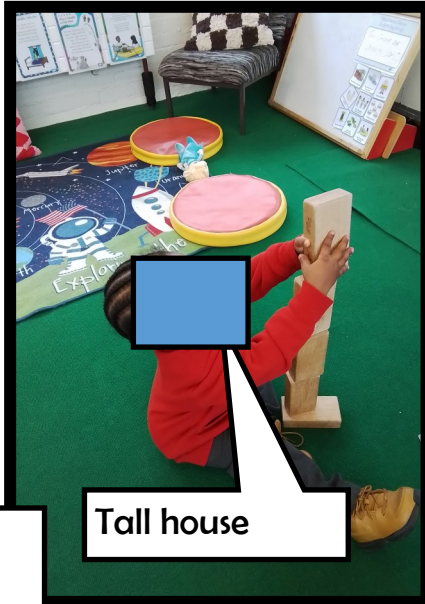


Celebrating Black History Month
