

# Forge Mill Farm Visit - Yellow 26.2.2026

## Purpose of the visit:

To enrich children's experiences by providing real-life opportunities of exploring a Farm. The children will be learning about Spring time and developing their vocabulary of animal names. We will explore the baby names of the animals too e.g. baby goat is called a Kid. The children had the opportunity to feed the animals and explore where the animals live and what do they like to eat? We have revisited environmental sounds- tuning into the different sounds the animals make. In Yellow Room, we will continue our learning through making a sensory farm, farm small world-play, reflecting on our visit through photos and mark making, tractor painting and using clay to pretend it is the mud we saw at the farm. We also look at the characteristics of the animals.
