We used lots of the materials that the children collected from the outdoor area at nursery to explore with paint. We did conker painting and rolled the conkers in a large tuff tray. We also explored leaf printing, looking in close detail at the detailed features of a leaf and exploring how autumn has made the leaves change colours. We also sorted the leaves into sizes—Big, medium and small. We also painted the Pumpkin and explored different woodland animals by going on a hunt. We learnt new names such as Hedgehog, Badger, Bat etc. We explored autumn in the continuous environment through water play, playdough etc.
